LGDCC Safety Rules and Policies

We want every participant to enjoy their time out on Lake George during our lake cruise. This is in no

way a race or timed event. So please relax enjoy your day, respect the rights of non

participants out on the water and please follow our simple rules below.

All participants must have a USCG Type III PFD on at ALL times during the run.

All drivers must register and sign our liability waiver

All drivers must abstain from alcohol use 12hours before the event and no alcohol on board during cruise.

All drivers must wear safety lanyards when available.

All participants must attend the safety meeting .

All boats must pay strict adherence to state and county speed regulations 45MPH

Including posted no-wake zones.

No passing the pace boat.

Every Vessel shall at all times proceed at a safe speed so that she can take

proper and effective action to avoid collision and be stopped within a distance

appropriate to the prevailing circumstances and conditions.

All boats must be insured

The LGDCC reserves the right to refuse entry to any boat or participant

Any participant may be removed during the run if deemed a danger to oneself or

others

A LGPC lake permit needs to be purchased and displayed as required.

All boats shall follow the pace boats and stay on the designated route and not take alternate routes to and from the stops.

A speed limit of 45mph is enforced.

If you are in need of assistance there will be pace and sweep boats.
